

OUR PROJECT



The **RE-ACT Schools project** addresses these challenges by focusing on **climate change adaptation** and **risk prevention in school outdoor spaces**. Schoolyards, especially in cities with limited public green living areas, are valuable assets that offer opportunities to test and promote **Nature-based Solutions** for **climate change mitigation**. The project brings together a diverse partnership from **six Mediterranean countries** (Italy, Spain, France, Croatia, Bulgaria, and Cyprus) to transform six schoolyards into green, climate-resilient spaces that promote healthy lifestyles.
